Lunta Malbec, Mendel, Mendoza, Argentina

Produced from fruit from one of Argentina's oldest Malbec vineyards planted in 1928 in Luján de Cuyo. Crafted by Roberto de la Mota, probably the country's most respected winemaker, who has worked with several top producers from France and now at the helm of the Mendel winery in Argentina. Deep and inky, the wine exhibits ripe raspberry, plum and bramble on the nose, followed by vanilla and toast from 12 months in French oak. Try with rich pasta dishes, or grilled meats.



Petit Verdot Stobi, Tickvesh, Macedonia

Known as a blending grape in Bordeaux, Petit Verdot has migrated to the warmer climes of Macedonia and in Tikeah, where protected by the mountains from the harsh winds, it makes a stylish single varietal wine. A classy choice to serve with roast beef or lamb and venison casseroles. Suitable for vegetarians and vegans, it can also be enjoyed with grilled Mediterranean vegetables.

Avondale Armilla MCC Blanc de Blanc Brut

Handcrafted using healthy, organically-grown Chardonnay grapes, and graciously given seven years on the lees, Armilla has had the time to develop an exceptional character and outstanding elegance. Voted winners of three top awards at the second Champagne & Sparkling Wine World Championships. The Paarl-based winery not only won Best South African Sparkling Wine overall, but also walked away with the trophies for Best Blanc de Blanc MCC and Best Organic MCC, making them the most successful South African sparkling wine in this competition to date.



Grüner Veltliner Talisman, Jozsef Torley, Hungary

Grüner Veltliner is a late ripening variety that typically produces wines that are pale green in colour and display fruit notes of grapefruits, limes, pears, and sometimes hints of white pepper. They normally possess a steely backbone of acidity which enables the best bottles to age gracefully. The grape's natural acidity accompanied by its restrained and understated fruit characters makes its wines ideal partners for food. A marvellous alternative to the more mainstream white grape varieties.

Picpoul de Pinet Domaine de la Serre

Known as the "Chablis of the South", the wines of Picpoul de Pinet are crisp, bright and refreshing. The name Picpoul, literally translates as "Lip Stinger", referring to the grape's naturally bright acidity.

The soft citrus fruit is tempered with an intense minerality giving a long, refreshing finish. Picpoul de Pinet is a classic match for oysters, mussels and seafood dishes.
